ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the Levens Bridge–Carlisle Trunk Road (A595) in the District of Copeland in the County of Cumbria.
