Declaration of National Nature Reserve in the Parishes of Shotley Low Quarter, Muggleswick and Healeyfield in the Counties of Durham and Northumberland.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 19 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and section 35 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that by the Derwent Gorge and Muggleswick Woods National Nature Reserve No. 1 Declaration 1992, made on 26th March 1992, the Nature Conservancy Council for England declared that the land containing 71.076 hectares or thereabouts situated in the Parishes of Shotley Low Quarter, Muggleswick & Healeyfield in the Counties of Durham & Northumberland and shown hatched on the plan attached to the said Declaration, is being held by the Nature Conservancy Council for England and managed as a nature reserve.

NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—YORKSHIRE REGION

Notice of application for licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that the National Rivers Authority—Yorkshire Region proposes to abstract the following quantities of water from a borehole in the Sherwood Sandstone at National Grid Reference SE 646299 (Carlton Lake Borehole) in the parish of Carlton, in the district of Selby, North Yorkshire. 150,000 cubic metres per annum, 1,000 cubic metres per day, 41.6 cubic metres per hour. The water is required for maintaining and augmenting the volume of water in Carlton Lake.
