The new sewage treatment works will replace the existing discharges from Cleethorpes southern outfall and Tetney Sewage Treatment Works, also eliminating a number of existing storm sewage overflows. The discharge is from National Grid Reference TA 3543 0320 to Tetney Haven within the East Lindsey District Council area.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Schedule 10 of the above Act that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority by Severn Trent Water Ltd. for consent to discharge up to 2,783 cubic metres (1,160 cubic metres per day under dry weather conditions) per day of treated sewage effluent, settled storm sewage for flows in excess of 32.2 litres per second (2,783 cubic metres per day), settled sewage and storm sewage in an emergency to the Tuxford Beck at National Grid References SK 7529 7256 (treated sewage effluent, settled sewage and storm sewage in an emergency) and SK 7531 7259 (settled storm sewage) from East Markham Water Reclamation Works. This is an application to replace an existing consent that currently authorises the discharge of 890 cubic metres per day of treated sewage effluent under dry weather conditions and settled storm sewage for flows in excess of 29 litres per second (2,506 cubic metres per day).
