Her Majesty the Queen has been graciously pleased to grant her Royal Licence and Authority to the Polytechnic of Huddersfield Higher Education Corporation so that it may bear and henceforth use the Armorial Bearings previously granted by Garter, Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster Kings of Arms by Letters Patent dated 11th January 1979 to the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Huddersfield for the use of Huddersfield Polytechnic which Armorial Bearings were granted and assigned pursuant to Her Majesty's Royal Licence dated 13th March 1975 to the Council of the Borough of Kirklees for the use of The Polytechnic, Huddersfield the management of which, under and by virtue of the terms of the Education Reform Act 1988, was transferred from the Borough of Kirklees to the Polytechnic of Huddersfield Higher Education Corporation as from the 1st April 1989; the said Armorial Bearings being first exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms, otherwise Her said Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect. #### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

The Trunk Road (A435/A46) (Alcester Bypass) (40 m.p.h. and De-restriction) Order 1992

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 82(2), 83(1) and 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into force on 8th April 1992 will be that that part of the A435/A46 trunk road, known locally as Alcester Bypass in the District of Stratford-on-Avon in the County of Warwickshire as specified in Schedule 1 to this notice shall be subject to a 40 m.p.h. limit and those lengths specified in Schedule 2 shall cease to be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Act and be subject only to the national speed limit. (A restricted road is a road on which a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. applies).
