#### UNIVERSITY OF LONDON ACT 1978

Notice is hereby given that a Statute made on 27th May 1992, amending the Statutes of the University of London has been submitted to Her Majesty in Council.

Notice is hereby further given that at any time within eight weeks (exclusive of any vacation of the said University) after the date of this notice, copies of the said Statute can be obtained on application to the Privy Council Office, Whitehall, London SW1A 2AT.

The purpose of the amendment is to enable the University to grant the Degree of Master in Science in the Faculty of Science. (10 SI)

#### UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the Governing Body of the University of Cambridge on 18th June 1992, amending Statute G has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The purpose of the amendment is to make the holder of the office of vice-chancellor eligible for election to a Professional Fellowship. (11 SI)

#### UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the Governing Body of the University of Oxford on 18th June 1992, amending Statute XV, has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The purpose of the amendment is to allow for surplus income of the Paget Toynbee Fund to be spent at the discretion of the board of management, either on the promotion of Study of Old French and Old Provençal Language and Literature, and the works of Dante, or carried forward for expenditure in subsequent years.
