TENDER FOR STERLING TREASURY BILLS

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, on Friday, 3rd July 1992, at 1 p.m., for sterling Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877 and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000 for Bills due 91 days after date and £100,000,000 for Bills due 91 days after date and £100,000,000 for Bills due 182 days after date.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000, £500,000, £1,000,000, £5,000,000 or £10,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday, 6th July 1922, to Friday, 10th July 1992.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent (being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates and different tenors.
