Notice is hereby given that Wirral Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at the times, lengths and sides of the roads specified in the Schedule.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to permit the picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, maintenance of roads, supply of gas, electricity and water in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and disabled persons' parking and hackney carriages to wait on authorised stands.

Details of the proposals are available at the Borough Engineer's Department, Civic Centre, Bebington, and a copy of the Order, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Borough Solicitor and Secretary's Department, Town Hall, Wallasey.

Wirral Metropolitan Borough Council Residential Parking Places (Longview, Seaview Avenue, Fairview Avenue, Merton Road and Silverlea Avenue) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that Wirral Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) designate that part of Longview Avenue, Seaview Avenue, Fairview Avenue, Merton Road and Silverlea Avenue described in the Schedule to this notice as parking places with permits during the hours 8.30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday.
- (b) Prohibit vehicles from parking in those places unless they display a valid permit issued by the Council for that purpose.

Permits will be issued to residents of the road, who are the owner of a passenger or goods vehicle or a motor-cycle.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to permit the picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, maintenance of roads, supply of gas, electricity and water in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and disabled persons' parking.
