TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Extinguishment of Public Right(s) of Way (Highway to the Rear of Monnow Street, Little Chippenham, Monmouth, Gwent) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order under section 251 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to extinguish any public right(s) of way over the length of highway described in the Schedule to this notice, being satisfied that the land which is subject to the public right(s) of way has been appropriated for and is held by the Monmouth Borough Council for planning purposes and that alternative rights of way will be provided.

A copy of the Order and plan have been placed on deposit at the offices of the Monmouth Borough Council, Mamhilad House, Mamhilad Park Estate, Pontypool, Gwent and at the Monmouth Area Office, Whitecross Street, Monmouth, where they may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Any representations or objections with respect to this Order may be made in writing to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL (quoting ref. ZC 510-5-3-18) not later than 30th July 1992. In the presentation of such objections it should be borne in mind that the substance of any such objections or representations may be communicated to other people who may be affected.

That length of unnamed highway at Little Chippenham, Monmouth, in the County of Gwent, situated to the rear of Monnow Street and leading to Howells Place, which extends from its junction with the cattle market access road for a distance of 90 metres in a north-easterly direction.
