Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

The variation applied for is to increase the water abstracted for cooling purposes from 22.1 million to 29.3 million cubic metres per year.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

ASHFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Ashford Borough (Restriction of Waiting) (Variation) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Various Roads, Ashford) Order No. 2, 1992.

Notice is hereby given that the Ashford Borough Council as agents for the Kent County Council made the above-mentioned Order on 26th June 1992, under sections 1(1) and 2, 2(1) and 2(c) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose or amend the Traffic Regulation Orders in the following roads which are required in relation to the construction of the roads forming the Beaver Road Diversion. The provisions of the Order will come into operation immediately for Norman Road and for the others as and when the new sections of road are opened:

1. *Impose no waiting at any time restrictions on certain sections of the following roads:*

Romney Marsh Road (new road), both sides from Beaver Road to the Newtown Road link

Newtown Road (new section), (Link and access to private section and Kimberley Works) both sides in the vicinity of its junction with Romney Marsh Road

Norman Road (new road), both sides in the vicinity of its junction with Beaver Road

Access Road to Beaver Industrial Estate, both sides from its junction with Beaver Road

2. *Amend the existing no waiting at any time restrictions in Beaver Road, Ashford*, in the vicinity of its junctions with Romney Marsh Road and A292 Ring Road.

A copy of the Order, relevant plans and statements of reasons for the Council wishing to make the Order may be inspected at the offices of the Borough Secretary and Solicitor, Civic Centre, Tannery Lane, Ashford, Kent, and the Director of Highways and Transportation, Kent County Council, Sandling Block, Springfield, Maidstone, Kent, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the power conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 2nd July 1992, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

BASILDON DISTRICT COUNCIL

The District of Basildon (Off-street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 11) Order 1992
