

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hereford and Worcester (B4096, Old Birmingham Road, Braces Lane and Linehouse Lane, Bromsgrove) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that on 25th June 1992 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on those lengths of roads in the town and district of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and/or unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects with police consent;
- (e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply and maintenance of any gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus;
- (f) the fire brigade, ambulance or police services;
- (g) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties (if no other road can be conveniently used).

An exemption in the Order also permits the waiting by disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme for a limited period of three hours, return prohibited within a further period of one hour.

The Order will come into operation on 7th July 1992.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of Parts I, II or III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Lengths of roads in the town and district of Bromsgrove in the County of Hereford and Worcester.

B4096 Old Birmingham Road both sides from a point 15 metres (49 feet) south-west of its junction with Braces Lane to a point 15 metres (49 feet) north-east of that junction.

Braces Lane, both sides from its junction with Old Birmingham Road for a distance of 15 metres (49 feet) in a westerly direction.

Linehouse Lane, both sides from its junction with Old Birmingham Road for a distance of 15 metres (49 feet) in a south-easterly direction.

Notice is hereby given that the Humberside County Council propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order the effect of which will be to:

- (a) to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. along the following lengths of road specified below:
 - (i) *Burringham Road (B1450)*:
 - (a) From its junction with Scotter Road roundabout in a westerly direction for a distance of 495 metres.
 - (b) From its junction with Scotter Road roundabout in an easterly direction for a distance of 47 metres.
 - (ii) *Scotter Road South (C221)* from its junction with Burringham Road roundabout in a southerly direction to a point 52 metres south of its junction with Betula Way, for a distance of 200 metres.

(iii) *Scotter Road (C221)* from its junction with Burringham Road roundabout in a northerly direction to a point 45 metres south of its junction with Brumby Wood Lane, a distance of 2215 metres.

(iv) *Scotter Road/Burringham Road Roundabout*. The entire carriageway of the roundabout.

(b) To revoke the following Order:

The County of Humberside (Scunthorpe Borough) (Scotter Road (C221) Scunthorpe) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1979.

The County of Humberside (Cleethorpes Borough) (Humberston Road/Hewitts Avenue, Cleethorpes) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that the Humberside County Council propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on the following length of road as specified below:

(i) *A1098*, that length of Taylor's Avenue, Cleethorpes, commencing at a point 67 metres south-west of its junction with Middle Thorpe Road in a south-westerly direction to its junction with the A1031 at the Hewitts Circus Roundabout, a distance of 435 metres.

A1098, that length of Hewitts Avenue, Cleethorpes, commencing at a point 32 metres north-east of its junction with Weelsby View in a north-easterly direction to its junction with the A1031 at Hewitts Circus Roundabout, a distance of approximately 1,300 metres.

A1031, that length of Humberston Road, Cleethorpes, commencing at the centre of Buck Beck Bridge in a north-westerly direction to a point 13 metres south-east of its junction with Davenport Drive, a distance of approximately 1,600 metres.

A1098-A1031, the entire carriageway of the roundabout situated at the junction of the A1098 and the A1031, known as Hewitts Circus Roundabout.

(ii) To revoke the following Order:

The County of Humberside (Cleethorpes Borough) (A1098 Taylor's Avenue and A1031 Humberston Road, Cleethorpes) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1988.
