PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

WAKEFIELD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

*The Proposed Council of the City of Wakefield (Pontefract No. 12); (Ryhill); (Crofton); (Hall Green); Smoke Control Orders, 1992.*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Wakefield, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, propose to make four Orders entitled the Council of the City of Wakefield (Pontefract No. 12); (Ryhill); (Crofton); (Hall Green); Smoke Control Orders, 1992, declaring the areas described in the Schedule hereto to be smoke control areas.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Orders, by virtue of section 11(2) of the Act, if, on any day after the Orders have come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control areas the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.
