The extended Conservation Area now includes part of King Henry's Road, Prince Edward's Road, Park Road, The Avenue, Bradford Road and De Warrenne Road. A plan showing the areas subject to the designation may be inspected at the Planning Department, Lewes House, 32 High Street, Lewes, East Sussex.
