RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND

NOTICE

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 (as amended) hereby give notice that on or after 6th July 1992:

- (i) Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The Chester—Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (Rhuallt Hill Improvement) (Bodeugan Lane Diversion) Compulsory Purchase Order 199.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales in exercise of his powers conferred on him by the above-named Acts has prepared a draft Compulsory Purchase Order, entitled as above, which he proposes to make, authorising him to purchase compulsorily the land described in the Schedule thereto for the purpose of:

- (i) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises at Waen in the

community of Tremeirchion, Cwm and Waen and County of Clwyd in pursuance of the Chester—Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (Rhuallt Hill Improvement Bodeugan Lane Diversion and B5429 Alterations Side Roads) Order 199;

- (ii) the execution of works on watercourses in connection with the construction of other highways mentioned above;
- (iii) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above.

Copies of the draft Compulsory Purchase Order and of the plan referred to therein, together with copies of the published draft of the above-named Side Roads Order, with their accompanying plans have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 8th July 1992 to 29th July 1992 at:

- (i) Clwyd County Council, Shire Hall, Mold, Clwyd;
- (ii) Rhuddlan Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Nant Hall Road, Prestatyn, Clwyd;
- (iii) The Clwyd County Council Branch Library, The Roe, St. Asaph; and
- (iv) The Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Government Buildings, Dinerth Road, Colwyn Bay.

Any objection to the draft Compulsory Purchase Order must be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary of State at the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase I, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, not later than 29th July 1992, and should state the grounds of objection and quote the ref. ZB750148-312-3. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
