

## EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Eastleigh (Red Lodge, Chandlers Ford)  
(Prohibition of Driving and Contra Flow Cycle Lane) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given, that on 7th July 1992, the above Order was made by the Eastleigh Borough Council with the consent of the Hampshire County Council under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) and (2) and 92 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) prohibit vehicles (except for pedal cycles) from entering that length of road, with a width throughout of 1.5 metres, on the north side of Red Lodge from a point 20 metres east of Bournemouth Road to the junction with Nursery Gardens; and
- (2) only allow pedal cycles to proceed in an easterly and south-easterly direction along the cycle lane.

The Order will come into effect on 16th July 1992. Copies of the Order may be inspected at my office at the Civic Offices, Leigh Road, Eastleigh during normal office hours. Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) and (2) and 92 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, make application to the High Court for this purpose.

## SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*New Traffic Proposals for the County of South Glamorgan*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of South Glamorgan, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends imposing traffic restrictions on the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule below. The nature of the restriction and the titles of the proposed orders are also shown in the said Schedule below.

Exemptions to the restrictions marked with an asterisk (\*) will be permitted for boarding and alighting from a vehicle; loading and unloading of goods, essential services and funerals, for a maximum of three hours, vehicles when displaying an "orange badge" and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons.

Full details of the proposals and plans showing the location and extent of the proposed restrictions may be seen at the address shown below during normal office hours.

Any objection you may have to any of the proposals must be submitted to me in writing by 29th July 1992, and must contain the grounds on which you object. Any such objection may be made available for inspection by any interested parties in accordance with the Local Government Access to Information Act 1986.

## SCHEDULE

## 1. Nature of Restriction and Lengths of Road Affected.

Prohibition of Waiting in:

- (i) \**Pen-y-Wain Road*, Cardiff on its north-east side from a point 10 metres north-west to a point 10 metres south-east of its junctions with Boverton Street, Kelvin Road, Hendy Street, and Werfa Street; and on its south-west side from a point 10 metres north-west to a point 10 metres south-east of its junctions with Inverness Place, Arabella Street and Donald Street; and on both sides from a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Morlais Street to a point 15 metres south-east of the same junction.
- (ii) \**Boverton Street*, Cardiff, on both sides from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 7 metres north-east.
- (iii) \**Kelvin Road*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 7 metres north-east.
- (iv) \**Hendy Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road, for a distance of 7 metres north-east.
- (v) \**Werfa Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 7 metres north-east.
- (vi) \**Inverness Place*, Cardiff on its south-west side from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 7 metres south-east.

- (vii) \**Arabella Street*, Cardiff on its south-west side from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 7 metres south-east.
- (viii) \**Donald Street*, Cardiff on its south-west side from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 7 metres south-east.
- (ix) \**Morlais Street*, Cardiff on both sides from a point 7 metres north-east of the closure at Pen-y-Wain Road to and across the closure.
- (x) \**Mackintosh Place*, Cardiff on its west side from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 20 metres south; and on its east side from its junction with Pen-y-Wain Road for a distance of 10 metres south.

## 2. Nature of Restriction and Lengths of Road Restricted.

Prohibition of Waiting in:

- (i) \**Violet Row*, Cardiff on its north side from its junction with Mackintosh Place for a distance of 10 metres west;
- (ii) \**Braeval Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Mackintosh Place for a distance of 10 metres west.
- (iii) \**Mackintosh Place*, Cardiff on its west side, from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Violet Row, to a point 10 metres north of this junction, and from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Braeval Street to a point 10 metres north of this junction.

## 3. Nature of Restriction and Length of Road Affected.

No Waiting 8 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday in:

*Cowper Place*, Cardiff on its north-west side throughout its length.

## 4. Nature of Restriction and Lengths of Road Affected.

Prohibition of Waiting in:

- (i) \**Albert Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Ninian Park Road for a distance of 10 metres north.
- (ii) \**Brunnel Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Ninian Park Road for a distance of 10 metres north.
- (iii) \**Craddock Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Ninian Park Road for a distance of 10 metres north.
- (iv) \**Gloucester Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Tudor Street for a distance of 10 metres north.
- (v) \**Kingston Road*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Ninian Park Road for a distance of 10 metres north.
- (vi) \**Littleton Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Ninian Park Road for a distance of 10 metres north.
- (vii) \**Railway Terrace*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Ninian Park Road for a distance of 10 metres north.
- (viii) \**Stephenson Street*, Cardiff on both sides from its junction with Ninian Park Road for a distance of 10 metres north.

## 5. Nature of Restriction and Lengths of Road Affected.

Residents Parking Place in:

- (i) *Mandeville Street*, Cardiff on its north-west side from a point 35 metres south-west of its junction with Neville Street for a distance of 48 metres south-west.
- (ii) *Gloucester Street*, Cardiff on its north-east side from a point 35 metres north-west of its junction with Tudor Street for a distance of 36 metres north-west, and on its south-west side from a point 30 metres south-east of its junction with Clare Gardens for a distance of 36 metres south-east.
- (iii) *Ninian Park Road*, Cardiff on its north side from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Craddock Street for a distance of 24 metres east, and on its south side from a point 25 metres east of its junction with Craddock Street for a distance of 24 metres east, and from a point 18 metres west of its junction with Craddock Street for a distance of 24 metres west. The residents eligible for permits being those living in house numbers 2 to 34 (even) and 1 to 43 (odd) Ninian Park Road.
