#### ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Essex County Council (Un-named Access Road to Swan Meadow Car Park, Saffron Walden) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992.*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

*Effect of the Order:* To prohibit waiting in the following road at Saffron Walden in the district of Uttlesford.

*The County of Gwynedd (Porthor) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1992*

##### PART 1

*No Waiting at any time*

*Cwmbowydd Road*, on both sides from its junction with A.470(T) High Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 20 metres south of that junction.

*Dolgaregddu*, on both sides from the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 200 metres in a north-easterly direction.

*Un-named Road* to rear of Blaenafon Terrace and Maenofferen Street on both sides from the junction with Glynllifon Street in a north westerly direction to the junction with Meirion Terrace.

*Meirion Terrace*, on the north side from the junction with New Road for a distance of 40 metres in a south westerly direction.

*Cromwell Street:*

- (i) Both sides from the junction with A.470(T) Church Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.
- (ii) On the easterly side from a point 18 metres south of the junction with A.470(T) Church Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
- (iii) On the westerly side from a point 30 metres south of the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.
- (iv) Both sides from a point 62 metres south of the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.
- (v) The southerly side of the end of the street for a distance of approximately 5 metres in an easterly to westerly direction.

*Alleyway* leading to Isallt Coet on both sides from the junction with Cromwell Street for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction.

*Alleyway* connecting Cromwell Street to Leeds Street on both sides from the junction with Cromwell Street for a distance of 2 metres in a westerly direction.

*Leeds Street:*

- (i) On both sides from the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.
- (ii) On the westerly side from a point 22 metres south of the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.
- (iii) Both sides from a point 74 metres south of the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.
- (iv) The southerly end of the street for a distance of approximately 5 metres in an easterly to westerly direction.

*Bowydd Street:*

- (i) On both sides from the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.
- (ii) On the easterly side from a point 20 metres south of the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.
- (iii) On the westerly side of the road from a point 18 metres south of the junction with A.470(T) Church Street for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.
