- Richmond Road*, west side from the junction with Atherton Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.
- Richmond Road*, east side from a point 5 metres south of Atherton Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

3. Standishgate, Wigan

The County of the East Riding of Yorkshire (Newbegin, Beverley) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969, the entire order.

Exemptions to the above will include permission to wait for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading, the maintenance of roads, gas, water and electricity supplies and for fire, police and ambulance purposes.
