ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A6514 Trunk Road (Valley Road, Nottingham) (Prohibition of use of Gaps in Central Reservation) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A6514 Trunk Road, the effect of which will be to close the six gaps in the Central Reservation on Valley Road, Nottingham, at its junction with The Repsol Petrol Filling Station (known locally as Norfolk House); Hadbury Road; Barlock Road/Rockford Road; Heatherley Drive; Harmston Rise and Ventnor Rise.

Notice of these proposals was first published in the *London Gazette* and the *Nottingham Evening Post* on 6th May 1988. However, due to the length of time that has elapsed since the original publication it is considered that, in fairness, further publicity should be given to the proposals.
