TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (City of Westminster) (No. 2) Order 1992" authorising the stopping-up of a part of the eastern footway fronting 13 Albemarle Street, London W.1.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of part of Crooks Lane, Alcester to enable development consisting of the erection of 91 dwelling houses and associated works to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Lovell Partnerships (Northern) Ltd., by the Stratford-on-Avon District Council under Part III of the said Act.
