ELLESMERE PORT AND NESTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston (Europa Way and Various Roads) Prohibition of Restriction of Waiting and One Way Traffic Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that the Ellesmere Port and Neston Borough Council (on behalf of the Cheshire County Council pursuant to an arrangement made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, has made the above mentioned Order under section 1(1) and (2), 1(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit any vehicles proceeding in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of Schedule 1.
2. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
3. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays for a period not exceeding one hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.
