4. To revoke the Borough of Ellesmere Port (Traffic Regulation) (Station Road) Order 1961, and the Borough of Ellesmere Port (Various Roads, Westminster) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969, insofar as it relates to the lengths of road specified in this notice.

The exceptions referred to will permit a vehicle to wait for the purposes of picking up or setting down of passengers, loading or unloading of goods, building or demolition works, roadwworks, the removal of obstructions to traffic and statutory powers and duties. Disabled person's vehicles will also be permitted to wait in the prohibited areas for periods not exceeding three hours at any one time with any interval of one hour between any three hour periods.

Full relevant details of the proposals are contained in a draft Order which, together with the relevant plan showing the lenghts of roads concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours.

Notice is hereby given that the Epping Forest District Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Essex County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) and (2) and 3(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to revise the existing parking regulations in Waltham Abbey through the unification and modification of previous Orders and the introduction of additional restrictions. The following restrictions will apply in the roads indicated:

No waiting at any time

(a) Highbridge Street:
