*The County Council of Humberside (Barton Eastern Relief Road) (Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of Humberside hereby give notice that they have made and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 for authorising the Council:

- (a) to carry out the improvement of highways;
