## WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

*Definitive Map and Statement of Public rights of way (Road used as Public Path No. 61 Silverdale, Road used as Public Path No. 19 Warton, Road used as Public Path No. 18 Bolton-le-Sands) (Roads used as Public Paths Reclassification) Order 1992.*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 14th July 1992, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order, by the County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by reclassifying as byways open to all traffic the roads used as public paths from 46876686 to 43187425.
