MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*Mid Glamorgan County Council (Various Roads, Gelligaer)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable Medical Practitioners and Veterinary Surgeons to visit while "on call" and for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, inspection or survey of the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, and a map showing the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Rhymney Valley District Council, Ystrad Fawr, Ystrad Mynach and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff during normal office hours.

*Lengths of Roads and Sides of Lengths of Roads in the District of
Rhymney Valley*

- (a) the eastern side of Penallta Road, Penybryn from a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 1 Penybryn Terrace, northwards to a point opposite the pedestrian entrance to Brynheulog Residential Home, a distance of approximately 540 metres (589 yards).
- (b) both sides of Penallta Road, Gelligaer from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with the unnamed lane fronting "The Lindens" and "Dan-y-Pentre", northwards to a point 15 metres (16 yards) north of the northern side of the same junction, a distance of approximately 56 metres (61 yards).
- (c) both sides of the unnamed lane fronting "The Lindens" and "Dan-y-Pentre", Gelligaer from its junction with Penallta Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).
- (d) both sides of Penallta Road, Gelligaer from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with Heol Cattwg, northwards to a point 15 metres (16 yards) north of the northern side of the same junction, a distance of approximately 44 metres (48 yards).
- (e) both sides of Heol Cattwg, Gelligaer from its junction with Penallta Road north-westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).
- (f) both sides of Penallta Road, Penybryn from a point 5 metres (5 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with the vehicular entrance to Brynheulog Residential Home, northwards to the northernmost point of its junction with Trosnant Crescent, a distance of approximately 64 metres (70 yards).
- (g) both sides of Trosnant Crescent, Penybryn from the northernmost part of its junction with Penallta Road south-westwards for a distance of approximately 38 metres (41 yards).
- (h) both sides of the spur road off Trosnant Crescent, Penybryn from its junction with Trosnant Crescent eastwards to its junction with Penallta Road, a distance of approximately 12 metres (13 yards).

- (i) the western side of Penallta Road, Penybryn from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with Gelliwen Street north-westwards to a point adjacent to the pedestrian entrance to Brynheulog Residential Home, a distance of approximately 86 metres (94 yards).
 - (j) both sides of Gelliwen Road, Penybryn from its junction with Penallta Road westwards for a distance of 20 metres (22 yards).
 - (k) both sides of the spur road off Gelliwen Street, Penybryn from its junction with Gelliwen Street north-eastwards to its junction with Penallta Road, a distance of approximately 15 metres (16 yards).
 - (l) the western side of Penallta Road, Penybryn from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with the unnamed road flanking Nos. 40 and 40A Penybryn Terrace northwards to a point 15 metres (16 yards) north of the northern side of the same junction, a distance of approximately 38 metres (41 yards).
 - (m) both sides of the unnamed road flanking Nos. 40 and 40A Penybryn Terrace, Penybryn from its junction with Penallta Road westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).
 - (n) the western side of Penallta Road, Penybryn from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with the unnamed road flanking Nos. 30 and 31 Penybryn Terrace northwards to a point 15 metres north of the northern side of the same junction, a distance of approximately 40 metres (44 yards).
 - (o) both sides of the unnamed road flanking Nos. 30 and 31 Penybryn Terrace, Penybryn from its junction with Penallta Road westwards for a distance 15 metres (16 yards).
 - (p) the western side of Penallta Road, Penybryn from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with Gelliargwellt Road northwards to a point 15 metres (16 yards) north of the northern side of the same junction, a distance of approximately 40 metres (44 yards).
 - (q) both sides of Gelliargwellt Road, Penybryn from its junction with Penallta Road westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).
 - (r) the western side of Penallta Road, Penybryn from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of the southern side of its junction with the unnamed road flanking Nos. 10 and 11 Penybryn Terrace northwards to a point 15 metres (16 yards) north of the northern side of the same junction, a distance of approximately 40 metres (44 yards).
 - (s) both sides of the unnamed road flanking Nos. 10 and 11 Penybryn Terrace, Penybryn from its junction with Penallta Road westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).
