

2. *Wern Road*
 (a) West and south-west side from a point 22 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Austin Road for a distance of 170 metres in a general northerly direction.

- To restrict waiting on parts of Caerau Road to a period of one hour (no return within one hour) 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday, except for vehicles displaying a current valid parking card.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) Picking up and setting down passengers.
 (b) Loading and unloading goods.
 (c) The maintenance of the roads.

 (e) For emergency purposes.
 (f) Local Authority duties.

- A One-Way Traffic Order to be introduced on part of Llanthewy Road.
- A Prohibition of Right Turns Order to be introduced to prohibit vehicles proceeding along Caerau Road, Newport to make a right turn into Clytha Park Road.
- As part of the Traffic Management Scheme, it is proposed to introduce road humps in accordance with section 90A(i) of the Highways Act 1980, at the following locations:
