GWYNEDD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Gwynedd (Various Street, Nefyn and Morfa Nefyn) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Gwynedd proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to:

1. Prohibit waiting at any time on the lengths or side of length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
2. To prohibit waiting between 1st June and 15th September on the length or side of lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
3. To prohibit waiting between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. between 1st June and 15th September on the lengths or sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.
4. Revoke the existing waiting restriction on the side of length of road referred to in Schedule 4 to this notice.

Exceptions will permit waiting in the lengths or side of lengths of road referred to in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 for:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;

and where necessary in connection with:

- (c) certain building operations;
- (d) the maintenance of the road;
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity, water or other statutory undertakings;
- (f) the exercise of local authority powers and functions;
- (g) the exercise of postal functions;
- (h) fire brigade, ambulance and police purposes;
- (i) and in certain circumstances when the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.

The draft Order, together with a map showing the lengths of roads concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at:

- (a) County Offices, Caernarfon;
- (b) The Post Office, Nefyn; and
- (c) The Post Office, Morfa Nefyn,

during normal business hours.
