Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority, Anglian Region by: A. J. Edwards and Son, Harling Farm, East Harling, Norfolk NR16 2JE. For a licence to abstract 68.2 cubic metres per hour, 1,500 cubic metres per day and 90,900 cubic metres per year, between April and the end of September, annually from bore hole at Grid Ref. Notice of application for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works and to abstract water.
