DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL**CLEAN AIR ACT 1956**

Proposed Doncaster Borough Council (Austerfield, Bawtry, Hesley, Tickhill) Smoke Control Order No. 30 1992

Notice is hereby given that the Doncaster Borough Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (as amended), proposes to make an Order entitled the "Doncaster Borough Council (Austerfield, Bawtry, Hesley, Tickhill) Smoke Control Order No. 30 1992" declaring the area described in the Schedule to be a smoke control area.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the above Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised carbonised fuels, gas and electricity. In addition, in accordance with section 9(1) of the Clean Air Act 1986, any person who acquires or sells any solid fuel, other than an authorised fuel for use in a building in the smoke control area shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £400.

If made the Order would not come into operation before 1st April 1993.

Copies of the Order and map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the offices of the Council's Borough Solicitor, Copley House, Waterdale, Doncaster, at all reasonable hours during the period of 6 weeks from 6th August 1992.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Council's offices at the address given above (quoting ref. L/BLE), object to the making of the Order.

SCHEDULE

All that area of land at Austerfield, Bawtry, Hesley, Tickhill, Doncaster totalling 3,400 hectares shown coloured green on the map annexed to the Order and which is bounded:

—To the north, by a line running in a south-easterly direction from a point where the southern boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 16 (Rossington) meets a railway line (grid ref. 5900, 9820) following the above Smoke Control Area No. 16 boundary line to a point where it meets the A638 (grid ref. 6470, 9570).

Thence by a line running in a northerly direction along the centre of the A638 to a point where the A638 meets an unclassified road (grid ref. 6440, 9720).

Thence in a south-easterly direction along the centre of the above unclassified road which parallels the southern boundary of RAF Finningley to the centre of a roundabout at the junction of the unclassified road and the A614 (grid ref. 6615, 9640).

Thence in a northerly direction along the centre of the A614 to a point where it meets the Doncaster M.B.C. boundary (grid ref. 6750, 9770).

—To the east and south, by a line running from the above point in a southerly and easterly direction following the Doncaster M.B.C. boundary to a point where the Doncaster M.B.C. boundary crosses a railway line (grid ref. 5990, 9115).

—To the west, by a line running in a northerly direction from the above point along the centre of the railway line to a point where it meets the southern boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 16 (Rossington) (grid ref. 5900, 9820).
