

—To the north, by a line running in an easterly direction following the southern boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 10 (Conisbrough) from a point where it meets the Doncaster M.B.C. boundary (Grid Ref. 4975, 9750) to its junction with the western boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 13 (Edlington) (Grid Ref. 5285, 9735).

The Borough of Halton No. 19 (Widnes No. 17) Smoke Control Order 1992
