The South Derbyshire District Council (Various Parishes) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given, that on 24th August 1992, the South Derbyshire District Council made this above Order under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation and the maximum period of waiting. The Order specifies the conditions under which the parking places may be used.

This Order will come into operation on 3rd August 1992. A copy of the Order which, together with the map showing the locations of the parking places may be inspected at the Civic Centre Offices, Civic Way, Swadlincote, Derbyshire, during normal office hours.

The draft notice was published in issue No. 52981 of the London Gazette dated 3rd July 1992. The reference number of that notice is A11288 and the effect of this Order is as described in that notice.

TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 5) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that on 21st July 1992, the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council made an Order under sections 32(1), 35, 39(6) and 101 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to amend the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1989 as follows:

(i) The Off-Street Parking Places situated at Old Street/Stamford Street, Ashton-under-Lyne, Burlington Street, Ashton-under-Lyne and Waterloo Road, Stalybridge shown on the plans annexed hereto shall be included in the Order.
