MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1971—SECTIONS 13(2) AND 15

Temporary direction withdrawing certain powers in relation to controlled drugs

DR MANOHAR VASUDEV RAY

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of subsection (2) of section 13, and by virtue of section 15, of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, by this Direction prohibits Dr Manohar Vasudev Ray MB, BS, a doctor within the meaning of that Act, whose registered address is Stoodley, 84 Walton Road, Stockton Heath, Warrington WA4 6NP, from prescribing, administering and supplying and from authorising the administration and supply of any drug which was, on 16th October 1991 a controlled drug within the meaning of that Act.

This direction does not extend to the doing of anything in circumstances where it may lawfully be done without being a doctor.
