EAST SURREY WATER PLC

Drought Order under section 74(2)(f)

Notice is hereby given that because of an exceptional shortage of rain over the past four winters, a serious deficiency of supplies of water exists within the Company's Statutory Area of Supply. The Company therefore intend to apply to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order under section 74(2)(f) of the Water Resources Act 1991 enabling the Company to take the following measures to alleviate the deficiency of water and to continue to supply sufficient water for essential purposes.

(1) To amend the Company's existing abstraction licence 9/40/3/386/S regulating abstraction by the Company from the River Eden in Kent through its intake at Chiddingstone for the purpose of filling Bough Beech Reservoir such that the Company may:

(a) abstract through its intake at Chiddingstone any water flowing in the River Eden in excess of 22 megalitres per day (4.8 million gallons), and

(b) abstract such water through the intake subject to the above constraint between 1st September 1992 and 31st May 1993.

Copies of a map showing the area affected by the above measures together with the existing abstraction licence 9/40/3/386/S may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable office hours at the Company's Principal Office at London Road, Redhill. NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—ANGLIAN REGION

Notice of application for licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority—Anglian Region by Waldersey Farms Limited, Parnella House, Market Place, Devizes, Wiltshire, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from Littleport and Downham Internal Drainage Board's drains, dykes and ditches within the boundary of Martins Farm: 100 cubic metres per hour, 1,454.7 cubic metres per day, 90,900 cubic metres per year from 1st April to 30th September at any point or points on the above mentioned drains.

The above application is to replace an existing licence which expires on 30th September 1992.

A copy of the application and of any map, plan or document submitted with it may be inspected, free of charge, at Pigeonville, March Road, Friday Bridge, Wisbech, Cambridgeshire, at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 31st July 1992, and ending 28th August 1992.
