GWYNEDD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Gwynedd (Various Streets, Tywyn) (Traffic Management) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Gwynedd proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to 2(3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be as follows:

- (i) To prohibit waiting at any time on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- (ii) To prohibit vehicles from proceeding along that length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice in any direction save as stated in Column 2 of Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exceptions will waiting for:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
 - (b) loading or unloading goods;
- and where necessary in connection with:
- (c) certain building operations;
 - (d) the maintenance of the road;
 - (e) the supply of gas, electricity, water or other statutory undertakings;
 - (f) the exercise of local authority powers and functions;
 - (g) the exercise of postal functions;
 - (h) fire brigade, ambulance and police purposes;
 - (i) and in certain circumstances when the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.

The draft Order, together with a map showing the lengths of roads concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at:

- (a) County Offices, Caernarfon; and
- (b) The Post Office, Tywyn

during normal business hours.

SCHEDULE 1

Lengths of road in Tywyn in the County of Gwynedd.

That unnamed road which runs past the Police Station and which connects the High Street with Back High Street; on the western side of the road from its junction with High Street along its entire length.

Red Lion Street; on the northern side of the road from a point 12 metres to the east of its junction with Church Street to a point of 42 metres east of that junction.
