The Norfolk County Council (King's Lynn) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the Norfolk County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles as follows:

No waiting at any time

Gaywood Road, north side, from a point approximately 160 metres west of its junction with St. Faiths Drive for a distance of approximately 45 metres in a westerly direction.

No waiting between the hours 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. from Monday to Saturday inclusive

Gaywood Road, south side, from a point approximately 169 metres east of Tennyson Avenue to a point approximately 160 metres west of the centre line of St. Faiths Drive.

The County of Northumberland (Berwick Town Centre) (Pay and Display) Parking Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that Northumberland County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 4(2), 45, 46 and paragraph 20(1) of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce pay and display parking on the following lengths of road in Berwick Town Centre:

(a) *Marygate:*

On the north-eastern side from a point approximately 15 metres south of the southern boundary of the bus station south-eastwards for approximately 104 metres.

On the south-western side from a point approximately 28 metres south of the southern channel of Golden Square southwards for approximately 35 metres.

On the south-western side from a point approximately 14 metres south of the eastern channel of West Street southwards for approximately 23 metres.

(b) *Hide Hill:*

On the eastern side from a point approximately 9 metres south of the southern channel of Woolmarket southwards for approximately 40 metres.

On the eastern side from a point approximately 55 metres south of the southern channel of Woolmarket southwards for approximately 33 metres.

On the eastern side from a point approximately 20 metres north of the northern channel of Silver Street northwards for approximately 15 metres.

On the western side from a point approximately 15 metres south of the southern channel of Marygate southwards for approximately 112 metres.

(c) *Woolmarket:*

On the southern side from a point approximately 10 metres west of the western channel of Ravensdowne westwards for approximately 42 metres.

(d) *Sandgate:*

On the eastern side from a point approximately 5 metres north of the northern channel of Palace Street northwards for approximately 50 metres.

On the western side from a point approximately 17 metres north of the northern channel of Drivers Lane northwards for approximately 40 metres.

The Charge for these spaces will be 10p per hour for a maximum stay of one hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday except for Marygate where the scheme will not operate on the market days of Wednesday and Saturday.

(a) *Wallace Green:*

On the western side from a point approximately 4 metres north of the northern channel of Walkergate northwards for approximately 48 metres.

On the western side from a point approximately 59 metres north of the northern channel of Walkergate northwards for approximately 34 metres.

On the eastern side from a point approximately 54 metres north of the northern channel of Parade northwards for approximately 62 metres.

On the eastern side from a point approximately 125 metres north of the northern channel of Parade northwards for approximately 17 metres.

Church Street:

On the eastern side from a point approximately 6 metres north of the northern channel of Parade northwards for approximately 35 metres.

On the eastern side from a point approximately 2 metres south of the southern channel of Parade southwards for approximately 32 metres.

On the eastern side from a point approximately 42 metres south of the southern channel of Parade southwards for approximately 32 metres.
