TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of a length of highway at Wormhill, Derbyshire, commencing in a southerly direction, at the intersection with Bridleway No. 47 for a distance of approximately 1,396 metres.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permissions granted to ICI C & P Ltd., and now vested in Buxton Lime Industries by Derbyshire County Council, on 29th March 1974, under ref. CHA/1173/5 and the Peak Park Joint Planning Board on 5th September 1991, under ref. NP/HPK/591/61.
