Manor Way) and runs in an easterly direction on a flyover over the said junction to end at a point approximately 5 metres west of Masefield Gardens; and

- (b) four routes for slip roads to connect the eastbound and westbound carriageways on the main new road with the A117 (High Street South) and the A117 (Woolwich Manor Way) at Beckton and East Ham in the London Borough of Newham.
- 2. An Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the A13 Trunk Road and the new Trunk Road to be constructed by him at Beckton and East Ham in the London Borough of Newham, which will:

(1) authorise him to:

- (a) improve highways,
- (b) stop up highways,
- (c) construct new highways,
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises,

all at Beckton and East Ham in the vicinity of the main new road; and

- (2) provide for the transfer of each new highway to the London Borough of Newham as highway authority as from the date on which he notifies them that it has been completed and is open for traffic.
- 3. The A13 Trunk Road (A117 Junction Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order (No.) 19, which provides for the purchase of:

(a) the land and rights described in Schedule 1 at Annex A hereto for the purposes of:

(i) the construction of the main new road and the slip roads at Beckton and East Ham in the London Borough of Newham in pursuance of the A13 Trunk Road (A117 Junction Improvement, Trunk Road and Slip Roads) Order 19 ;

(ii) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises at Beckton and East Ham in the said Borough in pursuance of the A13 Trunk Road (A117 Junction Improvement, Side Roads) Order 19;

(iii) the improvement of the trunk road at Beckton and East Ham in the said Borough; and

(iv) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;

(b) the land described in Schedule 2 at Annex A hereto for the purpose of being given in exchange for land which forms part of an open space.

4.
