Pursuant to paragraph 2 of Schedule 4 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, that part of Church Street, between Balfour Road and Bridge Road; that part of Bridge Road, between Church Street and Portmore Park Road; that part of Heath Road, between No. 9 Heath Road and Bridge Road and known collectively as The Quadrant, Weybridge, and (B366) Redhill Road, Cobham, along its entire length, be designated prohibited streets from 2nd November 1992."

The effect of the Resolution, is to prevent any street trading in those parts of the roads referred to in this notice, except those activities referred to in paragraph 1(2) of the aforementioned Schedule.
