ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The A13 Trunk Road (A117 Junction Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order (No.) 19

Open Space Land South of Newham Way, Beckton

The Secretary of State for Transport has prepared this draft compulsory purchase Order which he proposes to make. If made it will authorise the purchase of a right over land forming part of an open space as defined in the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, that is, land laid out as a public garden or used for the purposes of public recreation or a disused burial ground. This land is described in Schedule 1 to this notice and is shown coloured blue on the map referred to in paragraph 4 below. The right proposed to be acquired is described in Schedule 2.

2. The Order will be subject to special parliamentary procedure unless the Secretary of State for the Environment gives a certificate under paragraph 6 of Schedule 3 to the Act. He has been asked by the Secretary of State for Transport to certify under paragraph 6(1)(b) of Schedule 3 that he is satisfied that there has been or will be given in exchange for the right additional land which will as respects the persons in whom there is vested the land over which the right is to be acquired, the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights over that land, and the public, be adequate to compensate them for the disadvantages which result from the acquisition of the right, and that the additional land has been or will be vested in the persons in whom there is vested the land over which the right is to be acquired, and subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attach to that land apart from the compulsory purchase order. The land proposed to be given in exchange is described in Schedule 3 to this notice.

3. The Secretary of State for the Environment is required to give formal notice of his intention to issue a certificate before he reaches a decision, to give an opportunity for objections to be made. He hereby gives such notice. Open Space Land South of Newham Way Beckton

The Secretary of State for Transport has prepared this draft compulsory purchase order which he proposes to make. If made it will authorise the purchase of land forming part of an open space as defined in the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, that is, land laid out as a public garden or used for the purposes of public recreation or a disused burial ground. This land is described in Schedule 1 to this notice and is shown coloured pink on map (a) referred to in paragraph 4 below.

2. The order will be subject to special parliamentary procedure unless the Secretary of State for the Environment gives a certificate under section 19(1) of the Act. He has been asked by the Secretary of State for Transport to certify under section 19(1)(a) that he is satisfied that other land has been or will be given in exchange for the open space, which is not less in area and is equally advantageous to any persons entitled to rights of common or other rights and to the public, and that the land given in exchange has been or will be vested in the persons in whom the open space was vested, subject to the same rights, trusts and incidents as attach to the open space. The land proposed to be given in exchange is described in Schedule 2 hereto and is shown coloured green and described as plot number E1 on map (b) referred to in paragraph 4 below.

3. The Secretary of State for the Environment is required to give formal notice of his intention to issue a certificate before he reaches a decision, to give an opportunity for objections to be made. He hereby gives such notice.
