

(ix) specify that the penalty charge for parking in Schedule 2 or 3 parking places or the parking places in Methuen Road, Oaklands Road, Tower Road or Woolwich Road, either without paying the initial charge or for parking for a period longer than the period for which initial charge was paid or for parking in Schedule 4 or 5 parking places without displaying a valid permit would be payable, and that the unexpired time shown on the parking meter may be used free of charge, and the period during which a vehicle may not be returned to a parking place would be one hour; and

(x) provide that certain vehicles could wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum two minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no time limit).

4. The Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.) Order 1993 would further amend the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1991 (as amended) so that:

(a) (i) The existing restrictions on waiting by vehicles in parts of Broadway, Arnsberg Way and Highland Road which apply between 8 a.m. and midnight, Mondays to Saturdays inclusive would be amended so that the restrictions apply between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays.

(ii) restrictions on waiting by vehicles (other than in designated parking places) between the hours 8.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive would apply in parts of Broomfield Road, Highfield Road, Nursery Avenue, Oaklands Road, Pinnacle Hill, Rowan Road, Stonefield Close, Townley Road, Watling Street, West Street and Woolwich Road.

(iii) restrictions on waiting by vehicles (other than in designated parking places) between the hours 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. Mondays to Fridays would apply in parts of Chieveley Road, Dorothy Evans Close, Martens Avenue, Martens Close, Pinnacle Hill, Sevenoaks Close, Springfield Road and Spring Vale.

(b) Waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited.

(i) between 11 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the streets referred to in paragraph 4(a)(ii) above; and

(ii) between 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays in the streets referred to in paragraph 4(a)(iii) above.

(c) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the streets or parts of streets referred to in paragraph 4(a) above would be prohibited;

(d) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the streets or parts of streets referred to in paragraph 4(a) above would be prohibited except on Sundays, unless the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

5. The prohibitions referred to in paragraphs 4(a) and (b) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" would apply.

6. Copies of the Orders referred to in paragraph 1 above, of the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 1991, (and of the Orders which have amended that Order) of the Bexley (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1987 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order), of a map which indicates each road and length of road to which the proposed Orders relate, and of a statement setting out the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at:

(a) Reception, Bexley London Borough, Sidcup Place, Sidcup, Kent DA14 6BT, and

(b) The Information Centre, Civic Offices, Bexleyheath, Kent DA6 7LB,

during normal office hours, Mondays to Fridays for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published.

7. Any person wishing to comment on the proposed Orders may do so by writing to the Chief Engineer, London Borough of Bexley, Sidcup Place, Sidcup, Kent DA14 6BT, stating the grounds thereof, within the above-mentioned period of 21 days (paragraph 6).

8. Persons objecting to the proposed Orders should be aware that in view of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, this Council would be legally obliged to make any comments received in response to the notice, open to public inspection.

The Bexley (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order would be to prohibit the right turns into and from Thanet Road at its junction with South Road in the London Borough of Bexley.
