Notice of Reclassification Order

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

The Lancashire County Council Definitive Map (Road Used as Public Path No. 17 Paythorne) (Road Used as Public Path Reclassification) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 29th September 1992, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order, by the County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by reclassifying as a byway open to all traffic the road used as a public path from 81225173 to 83065132.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the

Ribble Valley Borough Council, Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe BB7 2RA, and at my offices, during office hours. Copies of the Order and plan may be purchased from my offices.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the undersigned (quoting ref. 71/AT) before 20th November 1992, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part thereof, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Lancashire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment may themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
