Notice of an application for a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority, Anglian Region by G. S. Haines & Sons, Parkers Farm, Langrick Road, Coningsby, Lincoln, for a licence to abstract 20,000 cubic metres per year between 1st December and 31st March in any year at National Grid Reference TF 252581 in the parish of Coningsby in the district of East Lindsey in the county of Lincoln from an unnamed riparian drain. The water is required for transfer to a winter storage reservoir for re-abstraction for spray irrigation during the summer.

Notice of application for licences to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that applications are being made to the National Rivers Authority, Anglian Region, by A. E. and W. A. Farr Limited of Newnham Manor near Baldock, Hertfordshire, for the renewal, on the same terms, of Licences expiring 30th September 1992, to abstract water as under:

- To renew Licence 6/33/14/56 authorising the abstraction of 123 cubic metres per hour and 1,841 cubic metres per day and 91,000 cubic metres during April to September from the chalk by means of a borehole at NGR TL 25613656 in the parish of Newnham in the district of North Hertford in the county of Hertfordshire. The water to be discharged to the Cat Ditch and Drain for spray irrigation purpose.
- To renew Licence 6/33/14/57/14 authorising the re-abstraction of the discharged borehole water at 123 cubic metres per hour and 1,841 cubic metres per day, and 91,000 cubic metres during
