ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Liverpool-Preston-Leeds Trunk Road (A59) Longton and Hutton By-pass) (Closure of Gaps in Central Reservation) Order 1002

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the Liverpool-Preston-Leeds Trunk Road, A59 Longton and Hutton By-pass, between Walmer Bridge and Howick Cross, in the Borough of South Ribble, in the county of Lancashire. The effect of the Order will be:

- (i) to close 13 gaps (specified in Part I of the Schedule to this notice) in the central reservation of the Trunk Road; and
- (ii) to prevent a right turn from the north-eastbound carriageway of the Trunk Road, through the gap in the central reservation (specified in Part II of the Schedule to this notice).

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order, or any of its provisions, on the grounds that:

- (a) it is not within the powers contained in the above Act; or
- (b) any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with,

may apply to the High Court before 30th November 1992 to suspend or reject the Order or any part of it.
