Revised traffic movements at Finsbury Circus/Moorgate

Notice is hereby given, that, the Common Council of the City of London on 16th October 1992, made the City of London (Prescribed Routes) (No. 9) Traffic Order 1992 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

Notice of the Common Council's intention to make the Order was first given in The London Gazette on 15th August 1992, Issue No. 52686, page No. 15645, ref. 761 and the effect of the Order is the same as given in that notice.

The general effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) compel the left turn by vehicles from Finsbury Circus into Moorgate;
 (b) prohibit the right turn by vehicles from Moorgate into
- Finsbury Circus; and
- (c) prohibit vehicles making a "U" turn at either end of the island site to be constructed at or adjacent to the junction of Moorgate and Finsbury Circus.

Exemption has been provided in the Order:

- (a) in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
- (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the City

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 26th October 1992, and of a plan showing the affected streets can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made from the date on which this notice is published in Room 123 West, The Guildhall, London EC2P 2EJ.

Alteration to Waiting Restrictions in Certain Streets in the City

Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of London on 16th October 1992, made the City of London (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 45) Order 1992 and the City of London (Leadenhall Market) (Amendment) Order 1992 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

Notice of the Common Council's intention to make the Orders was first given in The London Gazette on 14th August 1992, Issue No. 53020, page 13827/8, ref. 795, and the effect of the Orders will be the same as given in that notice.

The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order will be further to amend the City of London (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that in the streets and lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this notice, the hours during which the existing prohibition:

(a) on waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle
