CLWYD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Clwyd (Wrexham Inner Central Area) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that, on 20th October 1992, the County Council of Clwyd made the above-named Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to 2(3), 3(2) and 4(2) and part 4 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 the effect of which is:

- (1) To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding or remaining in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Sunday to Friday and between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturday except:
 - (a) Vehicles being used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) Vehicles used for works of maintenance or repair.
 - (c) With written permission of the Police or the said County Council.
- (2) To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice between the hours of 5 p.m. and midnight and between midnight and 11.30 a.m. on Sunday to Friday and from the hours of 5 p.m. and midnight and between midnight and 9.30 a.m. on Saturday except:
 - (a) Vehicles being used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) Vehicles being used for works of maintenance or repair.
 - (c) With written permission of the Police or the said County Council.
 - (d) Vehicles being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting of postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953, to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of road.
 - (e) Vehicles requiring access for the purpose of loading or unloading goods to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of road.
 - (f) Disabled persons vehicles.
- (3) To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the length of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Notice in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 2 of the said Schedule.
- (4) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice when access is permitted for the purposes of: alighting, boarding, loading, unloading and works of maintenance, repair and the like.

Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order to allow vehicles displaying both a disabled persons badge and a disabled persons parking disc to wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice when access is permitted for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from the previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same day).

(5) To amend the County Council of Clwyd (Wrexham Inner Central Area) (Traffic Regulation Order) 1989, to the extent that it relates to Henblas Street, Wrexham, and to revoke Articles 3, 4 and 5 thereof.

The effect of the proposed Order is to vary the hours between which vehicles may proceed or remain in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice which now includes the whole of Henblas Street and to extend the present one-way restriction to Henblas Street as specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 26th October 1992, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be examined at the Shire Hall, Mold, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or even on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 20th October 1992, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

- (a) That length of Regent Street/Hope Street which extends from its junction with Hill Street to its junction with Town Hill/High Street.
- (b) That length of Queen Street which extends from its junction with Rhosddu Road/Lambpit Street to its junction with Hope Street
- (c) That length of Henblas Street which extends from its junction with Queen Street to its junction with A5152 Chester Street.

CONGLETON BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Congleton (Bromley Road/Nursery Lane, Congleton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that on Wednesday, 21st October 1992, Congleton Borough Council made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1), to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the lengths of Bromley Road and Nursery Lane, Congleton, specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order will come into operation on Monday, 26th October 1992.

Exemptions are included in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) Picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) Loading and unloading goods;
- (c) Delivery or collection of postal packets;
- (d) The maintenance of the road;
- (e) The supply of gas, water, electricity and of any telegraphic line;
- (f) In pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (g) Disabled persons parking;
- (h) Police, fire brigade and ambulance services;
- (i) Weddings and funerals.

Full details of the Order may be inspected at Congleton Information Office, Town Hall, Congleton and "Westfields", Middlewich Road, Sandbach, between the hours of 9 a.m., and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is outside the powers of the Act or that any of the requirements of the Act or Regulations made under the Act have not been complied with you may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
