

(iii) The Borough of Dacorum (Marlowes and Hillfield Road, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1988.

(iv) The Borough of Dacorum (Bridge Street and Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1991

(2) To prevent any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

(3) To prevent any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

To prevent any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday in the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

Exemptions from the proposed Order will permit waiting for:

- (a) picking up or setting down of passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading;
- (c) emergency service vehicles;
- (d) disabled persons' vehicles; and, where necessary, in connection with:
- (e) building, industrial and demolition operations;
- (f) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (g) the maintenance of the road;
- (h) supply of gas, electricity and water; and
- (i) delivery and collection of postal packets.
