#### *The Lancashire County Council Definitive Map ( Road Used as Public Path No. 13 Paythorne ) ( Road Used as Public Path Reclassification ) Order 1992.*

Notice is hereby given that, the above-named Order, made on 29th September 1992, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order, by the County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by reclassifying as a byway open to all traffic the road used as a public path from 81565313 to 82575225.
