2. A scheme under sections 16, 17 and 19 of the Highways Act 1980, entitled "The M5 Motorway (Junction 18 and Avonmouth Relief Road) (Slip Roads, Special Roads) Scheme 1992" authorising him to provide for the exclusive use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1980:

(a) two special roads to connect the slip road, to and from the northbound and southbound carriageways of the M5 Motorway with the new Trunk Road roundabout referred to at paragraph 1(1) above; and

(b) two special roads to connect the slip roads to and from the northbound and southbound carriageways of the M5 Motorway with the roundabout referred to at paragraph 1(2)(d) above at the junction of the A4 Portway and the B4054 Avonmouth Road.

3. An Order under sections 18 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 entitled "The M5 Motorway (Junction 18 and Avonmouth Relief Road) (Slip Roads, Special Roads) (Side Roads) Order 1992" authorising him to:

(a) improve highways,

(b) stop up highways,

(c) construct new highways; and

(d) stop up private means of access to premises, all near the M5 motorway at Avonmouth in the county of Avon.

4. An Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 entitled "The A4 Trunk Road (Avonmouth Relief Road) (Side Roads) Order 1992", authorising him to:

(a) improve highways, (b) stop up highways,

(c) construct new highways,

- (d) stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises,

all at Avonmouth in the county of Avon, and providing for the transfer of each of those new highways to the County Council of Avon as from the date on which he notifies the Council that they have been completed and are open for through traffic.

Copies of each of the Orders and the relevant plans may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours from 30th October 1992, until 11th December 1992, or within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later, at the Department of Transport, 2 Marsham Street, London S.W.1; the offices of the Director, Constructon Programme Division, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ; the offices of Avon County Council, Avon House North, St. James Barton, Bristol; and at Bristol City Council, Planning Department, Brunel House, St. Georges Road, Bristol; and at the following libraries and post offices, Avonmouth Library, Avonmouth Road, Avonmouth; Shirehampton Library, Station Road, Shirehampton; Mace Stores Avonmouth Post Office, 195 Avonmouth Road, Avonmouth and Shirehampton Post Office, Station Road, Shirehampton, and at the Robin Cousins Sports Centre, West Town Road, Avonmouth.

Copies of the Orders numbered 1 and 2 above can be purchased through booksellers or direct from Government bookshops (HMSO). They are respectively numbered SI 1992/2593 and SI 1992/2594.

Any person aggrieved by an Order mentioned in this notice who desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provisions in it, on the grounds that:

(a) it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or

(b) any requirement of that Act or of regulations made under that Act has not been complied within relation to that Order.

may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date of the first publication of this notice. On such an application, the Court may suspend or quash that Order or any provision in it.
