Declaration of National Nature Reserve in the Parish of Lewknor in the County of Oxfordshire

Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of section 19 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and section 35 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that by the Aston Rowant National Nature Reserve No. 6 Declaration 1992, made on 5th November 1992, the Nature Conservancy Council for England declared that the land containing 32.45 hectares or thereabouts situate in the Parish of Lewknor in the County of Oxfordshire and shown hatched on the plan attached to the said Declaration, is being held by the Nature Conservancy Council for England and managed as a nature reserve.

Declaration of National Nature Reserve in the Parish of Lewknor in the County of Oxfordshire

Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of section 19 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and section 35 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that by the Aston Rowant National Nature Reserve No. 7 Declaration 1992, made on 5th November 1992, the Nature Conservancy Council for England declared that the land having an area of 15.91 hectares or thereabouts situated in the Parish of Lewknor in the County of Oxfordshire and shown cross-hatched on the plan attached to the said Declaration (which land was included in the Aston Rowant Nature Reserve No. 2 Declaration 1963 made by the Nature Conservancy on 14th May 1963), has ceased to be and to be managed as a nature reserve by the Nature Conservancy Council for England.

WATER RESOURCES ACT

NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—NORTH WEST REGION

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority, North West Region, by British Waterways, Willow Grange, Watford WD1 3QA, to vary the Licence No. 25/69/31/45 to abstract water from the Leeds & Liverpool Canal between National Grid Reference SD 373 096 and SD 374 098 at Aughton, near Ormskirk. The variation required is:

Existing: 45 cubic metres per hour, 454 cubic metres per day, 11.36 megalitres per year.

Proposed: 45 cubic metres per hour, 454 cubic metres per day, 13.63 megalitres per year.

Further details of the application are: water is to be used for spray irrigation purposes, May to August inclusive in any year.

A copy of the application and of any map, plan or other documents submitted with it may be inspected, free of charge, at Gore's Farm, Clieves Hills, Aughton, near Ormskirk, at all reasonable hours during the period beginning 5th November 1992 and ending on 3rd December 1992.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

BATH CITY COUNCIL

The Bath City Council (No. 9) Smoke Control Order 1993

Notice is hereby given that the Bath City Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 propose to make an Order entitled the Bath City Council (No. 9) Smoke Control Order 1993 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney or any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he/she proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, electricity and gas.

It is proposed that the Order shall come into operation on 1st October 1993.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge in the Chief Executive's Office at the Guildhall, Bath, during normal office hours during the period of 6 weeks from 12th November 1992.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the undersigned, object to the making of the Order.

CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Cambridgeshire County Council (Comberton Road and School Lane, Toft) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that on 26th October 1992 the Cambridgeshire County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which is to:

Prohibit waiting at any time in the vicinity of the junction between School Lane and Comberton Road (B1046), Toft.
