HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the west side of Evesham Road, Redditch from a point 234 metres (768 feet) north of its junction with Vaynor Drive for a distance of 26 metres (85 feet) in a northerly direction.

Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and/or unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects with police consent;

HUMBERSIDE COUNTY COUNCIL
