WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 20th October 1992, the Secretary of State for the Environment, acting under section 29 and Schedule 11 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, having considered the East Devon Pebblebed Heaths (Devon) Nature Conservation Order 1987, which took effect when it was made on 27th May 1987, and which remains in effect following his decision of 6th July 1987 has decided to make the East Devon Pebblebed Heaths (Devon) Nature Conservation Revocation Order 1992. A copy of the Revocation Order which was made on 20th October 1992 is reproduced in the annex to this notice.

The Revocation Order will not take effect until it is confirmed by the Secretary of State.

The general effect of the Revocation Order is to revoke the 1987 Order.

Representations or objections with respect to the Revocation Order may be made to the Secretary of State for the Environment (Wildlife Division), Room 908, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ, before 18th December 1992. They should be in writing and should state the title of the Revocation Order and in the case of objections, the grounds on which they are made should also be stated.

Copies of the 1987 Order and the map referred to in it and of the Revocation Order have been deposited at the offices of the East Devon District Council, Council Offices, Knowle, Sidmouth, and may be seen, free of charge, at all reasonable hours.

ANNEX

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981: SECTION 29

The East Devon Pebblebed Heaths (Devon) Nature Conservation Revocation Order 1992

Whereas:

1. The Secretary of State made the East Devon Pebblebed Heaths (Devon) Nature Conservation Order 1987 (the "1987 Order") which took effect when it was made on 27th May 1987;

2. The Nature Conservancy Council for England (English Nature) has since the Order secured the protection of the land described in that Order by the conclusion of a management agreement with the landowner;

3. The Secretary of State has consulted the English Nature; and

4. The Secretary of State has decided to make an Order revoking the 1987 Order.

Now therefore the Secretary of State in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 29(1) and paragraph 1 of Schedule 11 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that the 1987 Order shall be revoked.

This Order may be cited as the East Devon Pebblebed Heaths (Devon) Nature Conservation Revocation Order 1992.

This Order shall not take effect until confirmed by the Secretary of State.
