- (1) the sanction under section 49 of the Insurance Companies Act 1982 to a Scheme providing for the transfer to the above-named National Farmers Union Mutual Insurance Society Limited ("NFU Mutual") of the whole of the long-term insurance business carried on by Avon; and
- (2) an Order making ancillary provision in connection with the said transfer under Section 50 of the said Act.

Copies of the Petition, the Scheme, reports by the appointed actuary to the said companies and a report by an independent actuary in pursuance of the said section 49 may be inspected at each of the registered offices and at each of the offices of the said companies specified in the Schedule hereto during usual business hours for a period of 21 days from the publication of this notice.

Any person who intends so to appear, and any policyholder of the said companies who dissents from the Scheme but does not intend so to appear, should give no less than two clear days prior notice in writing of such intention of dissent, and the reasons therefore, to the Solicitors named below.
